Interagency Coordination

Contractors often do business with more than one agency. Responding to misconduct on one contract can impact other agencies' interests. We advocate for the DAF at an interagency council on a weekly basis to streamline this process for you.

Forensic Audit

Forensic audit support for suspected misconduct, such as deception, lies, and other illegal schemes, is a special expertise. We provide this expertise for you from various sources, such as the DCAA Office of Investigative Services, based on the unique needs of your case.

Congressional Inquiries, Public Affairs, and the Office of the Secretary of Defense

Misconduct and non-responsible behavior affecting our industrial base is a high-visibility concern. We coordinate with OSD, PA and liaison offices on your behalf to ensure consistency and accuracy in sensitive DAF messaging.

Negotiation of Settlements to Recover Funds Lost to Fraud, Bribery, and Corruption

Recovering funds stolen by bad actors is handled differently from ordinary litigation. We routinely coordinate with the criminal and civil divisions of DOJ's Fraud Section and Public Integrity Section in Washington, D.C. to obtain restitution and recoveries for your programs.
