Re: Notice of Debarment

Dear Ms. Anderson:

By letter dated November 26, 2010, the Air Force initiated proceedings to debar you from contracting with the United States Government. The letter provided you with an opportunity to submit information and arguments in opposition to the proposed debarment. To date, you have not responded to the Notice of Proposed Debarment.

Based upon the information in the administrative record in this matter, I have determined that protection of the Government's interests requires that you be debarred from contracting with the United States Government. The effects of debarment are those stated in the November 26, 2010, Notice of Proposed Debarment.

This debarment is effective immediately and continues for three years from November 26, 2010, the date you were proposed for debarment. Your debarment will terminate November 25, 2013.

MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF THE PROPOSED DEBARMENT OF:

DARIA EBRIO ANDERSON a/k/a
DARIA EBRIO HODGE a/k/a
DARIA EBRIO LEBLANC a/k/a
DARIA EBRIO MARTIRES

Effective this date the Air Force has proposed the debarment of Daria Ebrio Anderson from Government contracting and from directly or indirectly receiving the benefits of federal assistance programs. This action is initiated pursuant to Federal Acquisition Regulation ("FAR") Subpart 9.4.

INFORMATION IN THE RECORD

Information in the record establishes by a preponderance of the evidence that at all times relevant hereto:

1. Daria Ebrio Anderson ("Anderson") worked for E & M Enterprises, Inc. ("E&M"). Anderson is also known as Daria Ebrio Hodge, Daria Ebrio Leblanc, and Daria Ebrio Martires.
2. E&M is incorporated in Nevada and performs various building maintenance services, including carpet installation.
3. A U.S. Government contracting official ("Government official") sent a solicitation for service to E&M to install carpet in various Nellis Air Force Base ("NAFB") facilities.
4. On September 21, 2009, the Government official attempted to contact E&M's owner to remind him of the price quote due date. The owner was not available, but the Government official spoke to Anderson, who said she could meet the Government official at NAFB that morning.
5. Anderson delivered the E&M price quote to the Government official. After delivering the quote, Anderson told the Government official that she receives a twenty percent commission on contracts that she wins for E&M. Anderson told the Government official that she offers a kickback of five percent of her commission to whoever is responsible for awarding E&M a contract. Anderson then gave the Government official multiple business cards and told him to tell other people about her.
6. In a non-custodial interview with Government special agents investigating this matter, Anderson admitted that she offered the Government official a kickback for awarding E&M a contract, although she did not recall exactly the amount that she offered.

BASIS FOR THE PROPOSED DEBARMENT

The improper conduct of Anderson is of so serious or compelling a nature that it affects her present responsibility to be a Government contractor or subcontractor and provides a separate independent basis for her debarment pursuant to FAR 9.406-2(c).
